## Summary Annual Report for the ALASKA ELECTRICAL HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND December 31, 2006

This is a summary of the annual report of the Alaska Electrical Health and Welfare Fund (E.I.N. 92-6001972) for the year ended December 31, 2006. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The Joint Board of Trustees of the Alaska Electrical Health and Welfare Fund has committed itself to pay all medical, dental, and short-term disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

### Insurance Information

The Plan has contracts with Reliastar Life Insurance Company to pay specific stop-loss, life, and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. See the "Additional Explanation" section at the end of this Summary Annual Report for additional information on these contracts. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2006 were \$1,642,438.

### Basic Financial Information

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$(6,827,394) as of December 31, 2006, compared to \$(346,777) as of December 31, 2005. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$(6,480,617). This decrease includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$51,882,214 including employer contributions of \$45,083,242, employee contributions of \$5,712,324, realized loss of \$2,016 from the sale of assets, and earnings from investments of \$1,088,664. Plan expenses were \$58,362,831. These expenses included \$1,720,449 in administrative expenses, and \$56,642,382 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

2. financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. assets held for investment;
4. fiduciary information, including non-exempt transactions between the plan and parties-in-interest (that is, persons who have certain relationships with the plan);
5. transactions in excess of 5 percent of the plan assets; and,
6. information regarding any common or collective trust, pooled separate accounts; master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

Additional Information

Under the stop loss coverage contract with Reliastar, the total amount paid for premiums during the plan year was \$1,481,792.

Under the contract with Reliastar for life and accidental death and dismemberment coverage, the total amount paid for premiums during the plan year was \$146,913 and \$13,733, respectively.
